WALTON, Ind. — Emmett C. Armstrong, 70, Walton R.R. 1, died at 11:55 p.m. Saturday, June 30, 1979, in St. Joseph Memorial Hospital in Kokomo after an illness of one week.

Born in Cass County Jan. 11, 1909, he was the son of Francis Truman and Nellie Margaret (Gearheart) Armstrong. He was married June 25, 1931, to Ruth Bernice Davis, who survives.
