

A. M. Endicott Dies.

Civil War Veteran Passes Away at Galveston Home.

Abner Madison Endicott died early Friday morning at his home in Galveston following a long illness of complication of diseases incident to old age. He was a Civil War veteran and was born December 5, 1847. Mr. Endicott married Orla Anna Odell, daughter of the Rev. Price Odell, prominent Baptist minister, November 3, 1870. The widow survives with 5 children, Mrs. Grace Kepner of Tacoma, Wash., Mrs. C. G. McCool of Kokomo, Mrs. Lyda Harness of Burlington, Judge W. P. Endicott of Auburn, and Tom Edicott of Chicago. There are several grandchildren and great grandchildren. Another son, Ernest Endicott, died four years ago. Until he retired several years ago and moved to Galveston, Mr. Endicott was engaged in farming and lived 5 miles west of that place. The funeral will be held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Galveston Baptist church and burial will follow in the Galveston cemetery. Mr. Endicott was a member of the Baptist church.
