OBITUARY.

Jane Ann Fickle, daughter of David and Rebecca Fickle, was born in Marion County, Ohio, June 14, 1843, and departed this life January 1st, 1930, at the age of 86 years, 6 months and 14 days. When but a child she came with her parents to Indiana and the greater part of her life was lived near Galveston.

She was married to Michael Foy, who died in 1911. To this union nine children were born, seven of whom still survive, Mrs. Ida Tracy of Ft.
