Verl D. Sandifur, 94, Bunker Hill, died 1 p.m. Wednesday, Jan. 4, 2006, at Howard Regional Health System in Kokomo. He was born March 12, 1911, in Miami County, a son of Noah A. and Carrie O. (Duckwall) Sandifur.

He graduated from Bunker Hill High School in 1929 and retired March 31, 1976, from Wabash Valley Bank in Peru after 27 years of service. He also helped farm most of his active adult life. After his retirement from the bank, he worked for Mike's I.G.A. in Bunker Hill. He also worked 19 years for Leon Allen at the Allen Funeral Home in Bunker Hill.

He was a member of First Baptist Church in Bunker Hill, where he played the church piano for many years. He was a past master and member of the Bunker Hill Masonic Lodge F & AM No. 683, Walton Order of Eastern Star No. 184, Peru York Rite Bodies, Fort Wayne Scottish Rite, and Order of Amaranth Lodge Logansport Court No. 4.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one brother, Earl Sandifur; one sister and brother-in-law, Edna and John Davisson; a niece, Anna Marie Kent; and a nephew, John Davisson.

Services are 11 a.m. Saturday at First Baptist Church in Bunker Hill, with the Rev. Charles Layne officiating. Burial will be in Galveston Cemetery.
