Robert R. Schuett, 78, Kokomo, died 4:17 p.m. Monday, March 8, 2004, at Manor Care Health Services. Born April 15, 1925, in Melrose Park, Ill., he was the son of Frank and Clara (Haack) Schuett. On June 26, 1971, in Winona Lake, he married Maybelle Runk Schuett, who survives.
