Julia Mae Stedman was one of two children of Willaim A. and Jessie (Dye) Stedman. She was born June 6, 1904 in Miami, but when very small she moved with her parents to a farm east of there where she lived until six years ago when they moved to the present home in Bennetts Switch.

Both her parents proceded her in death, her father passed away July 11, 1930, and her mother February 18, 1946. She had been in ill health for four years, and in May, 1947, she underwent her third operation. But nothing could cure her ailment which was of a malignant character, and her death occured at her home at 1:30 p.m. Sunday July 20, 1947.

Survivors include one sister, Effie Stedman, who lived with her; four uncles, Charles and Roy Dye who live near Bennetts Switch, Benjamin Dye of Cutler; and James Stedman of Miami; and two aunts, Mrs. Dollie Schick and Mrs. Golda Keal, both of Marion.

Services were from the residence with Rev. Thomas Shively officiating. Final resting place, Galveston Cemetery, Galveston, IN.
